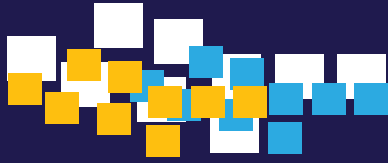

Intelligent business on the go with Inmarsat

Dubai, United Arab Emirates, April 2, 2007: Inmarsat, the leading provider of global mobile satellite communications, will be participating in the 10th Annual ARABCOM 2007 Summit for the 6th year in a row. Inmarsat has been a vital source of business success for major corporations and industries across the world, developing new technologies that redefine the standard for the industry and delivering innovative solutions in par with the demands of today's enterprise mobility wave.

Mobile applications are used in a majority of enterprises and are even deployed among small and medium-size businesses. The shift from mobile applications to mobile employees is another emerging trend, forcing companies to address the technology needs of a broader range of mobile applications and armour their people with connectivity that will further their business aims and efficiency.

As businesses are constantly on the go and mobility becomes a crucial feature of enterprise communications, an important mission for Inmarsat is to continually help companies and individuals perform their tasks efficiently and effectively with intelligent business solutions. One such example is the BGAN (Broadband Global Area Network) service, an all-in-one solution that offers simultaneous voice and broadband data connectivity through a highly-portable terminal. To date, BGAN has 7,119 active subscribers registered on the Inmarsat network and has been used in 191 countries around the world by international broadcasters for live news reports, by aid agencies in relief efforts and crisis response, by the world's leading oil and gas companies at exploration sites, and governments in emergency response, and by different sectors, companies, and individuals.

At the ARABCOM exhibition this year, representatives from Inmarsat will showcase the latest technology from Inmarsat, including live demonstrations of BGAN.
